Hazardous Waste Facilities Operating Permit Decision Status Report

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SB 158 Statutory Requirements Hazardous Waste Facilities Operating Permits

- Senate Bill 158, imposed permit decision timelines for operating permits expiring before January 1, 2025, and on or after January 1, 2025.
- For permits expiring before January 1, 2025, DTSC is required to issue a decision on permit renewals either:
 - Within three years after the end of the permit's fixed term
 - Within three years of the effective date of the statute, whichever is later

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- If a permit decision has not been issued by the applicable deadline, DTSC shall issue a report, which shall be released to the public and the facilities.
- The report should address the following:
 - Reasons for the delays
 - Provide permit status updates
 - Propose schedules for finalizing permit decisions
- Boards responsibility to Accept or Modify the proposed schedule
