

 - Medical sterilization facility
 - Carson, CA (Los Angeles County)
- Search Warrant Execution on July 17, 2025
 - LA District Attorney and DTSC's Office of Criminal Investigation
 - Led to felony charges; allegations include:
 - Exposure of employees to hazardous levels of ethylene oxide
 - Falsified documents and illegal waste practices









Hazardous Waste Management Plan




