Action Item Follow-Up from November Board Meeting

- Vice Chair Strauss-Hacker requested that the DTSC senior management team report back to the Board prior to the next Board meeting on their efforts to digitize the administrative record.
- DTSC will have the digitized appeal AR prepared in accordance with the Standing Order for the two final permit decisions expected in 2026.

- Chair Rakestraw requested a briefing from DTSC about the 2020-2024 Strategic Plan outcomes report and how that will inform the current plan development.
- DTSC is taking a different approach to the new strategic plan, including incorporating prior feedback and the Director's Annual Priorities.
